## FOOTBALL NSW STATE AWARD 2016

### Tony Davies – MWFA and Beacon Hill Youth Club Football Club



Tony commenced his involvement in Football in 1980 when his son joined Beacon Hill Youth Club / Football Club in an Under 7 team as a Manager and Assistant Coach. In 1983 he became Coach of the team & continued until 1989, developing the team from 10 Division 5 to 16 Division 1.

In 2000, after his son decided to leave Football, Tony took up a role of Manager with an U10-5 team of new-comers, ending with the All Age Division 1 team in 2008;

Tony started attending Beacon Hill Football Club Meetings in 1980 as Assistant Secretary and in 1982 became Secretary of the Beacon Hill Youth Club/Football through to 2008.

From 1982, Tony acted as Assistant and Delegate from Beacon Hill YC / Football to the MWFA and attended Council of Clubs' Meetings.

During the twenty-nine years from 1980 till 2008, inclusive, Tony had many Club roles other than Secretary. He has fulfilled the roles of Competition Secretary, Insurance Officer, Child Protection Officer, Archives Officer, Results Officer, Newsletter Officer, Delegate to Beacon Hill Youth Club, Delegate to MWFA Council of Clubs, Presentations' Co-ordinator, Friday Night Info Sessions Co-ordinator, Coaching Assistant to Coaches, Club Web Site Developer as well as taking on many other tasks that cropped up especially when the Club was still growing and volunteers were hard to find;

In 1999 he became the Assistant Secretary of the MWFA, which is a position he remains in today.

Tony is the MWFA Results-Liaison Officer for 'Football NSW State Cups', as well as for the 'Champion-of-Champions' Tournament (2007 to current) and attends all Manly based games to ensure all runs smoothly.

Tony also volunteers as an Official at matches in FNSW State Cups and Champion of Champions Tournaments, especially their Semi-Finals and Finals.

In 2014 he was elected as MWFA Vice-President – Miniros Football and runs referees courses and Information sessions for these age groups at the beginning of each season.

Tony received Life Membership of the Beacon Hill Youth Club, in 1990, Life Patron in 2014 and was awarded an MWFA Meritorious Service Award for service to Football in Manly Warringah in 2004.

### Rhonda Ferguson – MWFA and Harbord Seaside United



Rhonda started playing football in the mid-1970's, in mixed sub-junior and junior teams for Beacon Hill and was a part of the first ever Junior Girls competition in Manly Warringah in 1978 playing for Beacon Hill Ladies Soccer Club in under 11's.

She played for many years in MWFA competitions and even in the Gladesville Women's (now North West Women's) competition.

Rhonda also played in the inaugural Women's State League competition (now Women's Premier League), firstly as a club competition then for the MWFA.

As many players still do, Rhonda also played Futsal, from the early days when it was a bouncy tennis ball to International Rules –

representing MWFA, NSW and Australia along the way.

Rhonda moved to Seaside, where she played Women's Premier League. Seaside amalgamated with Harbord to form Harbord Seaside United FC in 2004, and she is still playing and coaching Over 35's there.

She also coaches her daughter's team at Dee Why FC

She has qualified as a referee – refereeing both men's and women's games for many years.

Over the years there have been a number of amalgamations of MWFA Clubs to form the current 17 Clubs. A brief history is given below:

Avalon Junior and Senior Clubs merged in 1982.

Belrose Rangers Soccer Club (founded 1978) and Terrey Hills Soccer Club merged in 1986 to become the BTH Raiders Football Club.

Brookvale FC started as Manly Milan Soccer Club in 1962 and then changed name to Brookvale FC in 1971.

Manly Soccer Club (founded 1949) and Allambie Soccer Club (founded 1963) merged in 1992 to become the Manly Allambie United Football Club

Forest Killarney Soccer Football Club formed in 1962 with 2 teams and then split in 1969 to form Killarney Heights Soccer Club and Forest Soccer Club. These two Clubs then merged again in 1993 to form Forest Killarney Football Club

Cromer Strikers Soccer Club and Collaroy Plateau Youth Club merged in 1995 to form Collaroy Cromer Strikers Football Club.

Pittwater was formed in 1964 as a soccer section of the Pittwater RSL Youth Club. In 1966 the Football Section became a separate entity - what is now Pittwater RSL FC.

Harbord Diggers Soccer Club (founded 1947/48) and Seaside Soccer Club (Men's founded 1982 and joined by Queenscliff Women's in 1991) merged in 2004 to form Harbord Seaside United Football Club



## DEE WHY FOOTBALL CLUB - 70 YEARS IN 2016

The first Dee Why Football Club was established in 1926 as the sport started to take a hold in Australia. Sadly, due to the depression and the Second World War the club was short lived and disbanded as men travelled first for work and secondly for war. After the war the young men of the area and the returning servicemen created the Dee Why Amateur Soccer Football Club, initially with members from the Dee Why Men's Amateur Swimming Club. One team was formed, playing on Sundays against Granville & Lane Cove on a round robin basis. At this time the home ground was 'Duncum's Reserve' at South Creek Rd.



- In 1950 the First all-age team was formed, Dee Why won the Grand Final 2-0 against Narrabeen.
- In 1953 the club president, Sir Robert Askin (later to be Premier of NSW), secured re-location of the club to Dee Why Oval. Registration for Seniors was 5 shillings (50c), Juniors was 2 & six (25c)!
- In 1966 Dee Why entered Div. 3 of the Inter-suburban League and the club was awarded Champion Club of the MWSA.
- In 1979 Dee Why Soccer Club entered a team in the first year of the MWFA Premier League and the 1st Dee Why Women's team was formed. Additionally, the Dee Why Federation team won Div. 3 and was promoted to Div. 2 in what was a great year for the club!
- The 80's started well for Dee Why Football Club, winning the Umbro Cup (beating North Bankstown 2-0) in 1980, and the Dee Why Federation team also won Div. 2 and the Grand Final (beating Mt Druitt 5-3 on penalties) The following year the club was promoted to the Federation Div. 1.
- 1983 marked another huge milestone for the club with George Best playing for Dee Why on Wednesday 27th July in an exhibition match against Manly Warringah, with "The Belfast Boy" hitting the score sheet for the Swans!
- In 1996 the PL team in MWFA won the Grand Final (beating Pittwater 2-1) and scored the double, also winning the MWSA Cup.
- It was a few years between drinks and in the Olympic Year the Premier League Reserves won their Grand Final (beating Pittwater 2-0) and then went on to win the League title the following year.
- In 2003 the Premier League won the SA cup (beating Manly Vale 5-0) and marked the end of a solid run of trophies for the club before being demoted to AL1 in 2008.
- In 2014 Dee Why FC won the AL1 Championship and were promoted back to the Premier League. 2016 saw the Club finish 5th.

With new record membership and increasing ambitions in Junior and Women's Football, Dee Why Football Club is looking forward to it's next milestone!

The 70th Anniversary celebrations for the club kicked off with an amazing Gala Dinner at Dee Why RSL Club. It was an amazing evening with over 200 attendees enjoying outstanding canapes, food and drink. The 70th Anniversary Dinner welcomed life members of DYFC as well as some special former players including two gentlemen who had played in the inaugural 1946 Side. We were really lucky to have SBS reporter Mariana Rudan host the event as well as special guests including former Dee Why FC and Central Coast Mariners coach Phil Moss and former FIFA World Cup head of operations Brian Emery.

The celebrations culminated in a Junior Football Carnival with over 200 kids enjoying football games, a BBQ and face painting ahead of a special presentation. The carnival concluded with a Legends Game with the U18 I team facing off against a Club Legends XI, with the youngsters edging it on penalties after a 2-2 draw.

All in all an amazing season that was topped off with 5 grand final wins to celebrate too.

Over the years the roles and responsibilities of several existing Management Committee positions were moved into the full time MWFA Administration roles.

The main tasks performed are financial management, management of the draw and rescheduling of washout games, results and tables management, website management, and the publishing and distribution of the Soccer Post (since 2009).



## PRESIDENT'S REPORT

As we look back after another great year of football in Manly Warringah we can all be proud of the success that all areas of the association has achieved in 2016. I just can't believe how fast the season goes. We look forward to the football season starting and before we know it, it's over.

The start of the season was dry which allowed our 17,000 plus players a great rain free beginning. In the back end of the season we lost a few days to the weather but most comps got all their games played before the semi-finals.

The highlight of my year, as usual, was working on the grand final days at Cromer Park and see all the smiling faces. This year the weather gods were kind and the football top class from the under 12's through to our golden oldies, the over 35 and even the elite over 45's.

This year we have begun a process to engage with all MWFA stakeholders including our 17 clubs to collect information to allow us to improve the performance and to implement a strategic plan for football on the Northern Beaches. The first series of workshops have been held and 2017 should see us release the results and then we can push on with improving and updating our constitution.

In 2016 a number of new policies came into play which I believe contributed in delivering the closest PL competitions in many years. These policies included the Amateur policy, Player Quota policy, the academy direction policy and MWFA Premier League application and participation agreements.

These documents and policies have been put in place with the support of the clubs to continue to improve the great game here in Manly Warringah as well as to ensure all clubs are playing on a level playing field.

We have again this year worked together with the Manly Warringah Football Referees Association (MWFR). It is unfortunate to still have an issue with referee abuse especially since this has been mentioned in annual reports for many, many years. Again this year the judiciary has had far too many cases of referee abuse. I know of quite a few referees that have given it away because of the constant and unrelenting abuse, especially in the junior ranks. We, as a combined group, need to address this situation. It starts at club level; it's very hard to improve the situation when sometimes clubs support their players in cases of referee abuse, instead of imposing their own sanctions or suspensions. Again we need to be working together to improve the situation. Again this year the player referees system worked well without being perfect. We still have a good working relationship with the referee association, unlike some other Sydney associations, and we need to keep working together to improve the standard and treatment of all referees.

I have been working with the new Northern Beaches Council administrator to ensure that our voices are heard. With the first elections being held in September 2017 we need to become more political to make sure that some of the funding from the state government makes it way to grass roots football.

I am still on the executive of the sporting union which is negotiating with the new council in regards to field allocations moving forward. I will endeavour to ensure that we get more access to more grounds in 2017.

I wish to thank all the Executive and Management committees for all their efforts and more importantly, their time over the past year, and I look forward to working with them all again over the next 12 months. A special thank you to our hard working team in the office headed again by Jeremy, our general manager.



A special mention must go to Lee-Anne who works well beyond what is expected. The work load in the office has increased just like our registration numbers and we should never underestimate the efforts of all the team that make our great game run so smoothly.

Lastly I would like to thank my wife, Wendy and my kids for the support and for allowing me to give something back to the game that has given me and my family so much enjoyment over many years. Let's all work together to ensure the continued success in 2017.
