R4 – Denies the opposing team a goal or obvious goal scoring opportunity by deliberately handling the ball

R5 – Denies an obvious goal scoring opportunity to an opponent moving towards the players goal by an offence punishable by a free kick or penalty

R6 – Use offensive or insulting language and/or gesture

R7 – Receives a second caution in the same match

1. At section 6.6(g) there is a reference to 'Disciplinary Committee' in the 1st line. Probably should be 'Judiciary Committee'.
2. At section 6.10 (b), 1st sentence, 2nd line, there is reference to 'an MWFA completion' and I think it probably should be 'MWFA competition'.

Comment: Will check the new Constitution to ensure these are addressed.

14.14 Change 13:

2018 MWFA Premier League Competition

The 2018 MWFA Premier League will play one match per round at Cromer Park on the Friday evening to assist in alleviating pressure on fields on Saturday afternoons and to further elevate the status of the MWFA Premier League and forge closer links between all of the Northern Beaches Football Community.

The matches will be identified at the release of the Premier League draw with an even spread of home matches for the 10 participating clubs.

The First Grade game kicks off at 7.30pm on the Friday evening at Cromer Park No. 1 and the Reserve Grade match to be played on Saturday afternoon and the ground of the home team with one rule change that states: **With the exception of the goalkeeper, any player who starts the First Grade on Friday evening is not permitted to take part in the Reserve Grade game. Where the goalkeeper from the First Grade match plays in the Reserve Grade match the player must play as a goalkeeper.**

14.15 Change 14:

IFAB has approved the use of temporary dismissals (sin bins) subject to the approval of the competition's national FA. The FFA Referees Committee has approved the use of temporary dismissals. In Australia, any competition that wishes to use temporary dismissals must adhere to these basic guidelines:

1. Any player who is **cautioned for dissent** will be punished by a yellow card and a temporary dismissal period of:
 - Ten (10) minutes, for matches greater than 60 minutes in duration; and
 - Five (5) minutes, for matches of 60 minutes or less in duration.
2. All other cautionable offences are punished with a yellow card.
3. The referee will manage the timing of the dismissal period and/or may delegate this responsibility to one of The Other Match Officials.

Proposal: This will be trialled in 2018 in the U18-1 Friday night games and in the MWFA Cup.

14.16 Change 17:

By Law 21 (b) Add the words "Coaches and team officials are limited to a maximum of four."

By Law 21 (c) "Team Coaches, Managers and other team officials shall wear (displayed on the front and visible at all times) current MWFA ID card"

Comment: This has been done in the wording of the new Constitution which incorporated the rules sent out this year.

14.17 Change 18:

ByLaw C4 (a) All players **U16** to Premier League shall wear numbered shirts, those numbers shall correspond with the player's name on the Match Sheet.

Change To:

All players **U12** to Premier League shall wear numbered shirts, those numbers shall correspond with the player's name"

Change also required in Section L Group 2 last bullet point replace U16 with U12.

Comment: This is a proposal to have the shirts for all competition Age Groups U12 up to be numbered compared to the current U16 and up,

CARRIED

14.18 Change 21:

By Law E6 A (a) Para 2 On each competition day where the team is playing as a *home* team one of the team referees must officiate: etc

Replace the word "home team" with "away team" each time these words appear.

Comment: This is replacing the current home team supplying the team referee to the away team providing the team referee.

CARRIED

14.19 Change 23:

By Law E6 D "Each team must check the ID card or photo ID of the Team Referee"

Comment: This will be added to the Constitution

CARRIED

14.20 Change 24:

Proposal: That there be unlimited borrowing of players from U18 Age Group to the Premier League.

Discussion: This is a proposal to amend the constitution regarding the borrowing eligibility of players to Premier League sides in the men's division.

As per the current ruling a player may not be borrowed more than 4 times in a season. We would like to present the following case for there to be unlimited borrowing from U18s to Premier League.

The reasons for proposing this amendment are as follows:

- At the beginning of every season, Premier League sides are required to take several players to try and account for injury, illness, vacation and work; as well as numerous other commitments faced by amateur footballers. The availability of players varies and clubs take between 32 and 42 players per season in the attempt to ensure they are never left short. If a club takes only 32 players and they have an unfortunate season regarding injuries/illness etc, they are left short and are limited by the players they can bring in to support them. If a club takes a 38 - 42 players, they not only limit opportunities young players have to experience Premier League football (though not ready for it full time yet) they also are faced with a situation of having to leave out several players every week if no injuries/illnesses occur. If clubs could borrow freely from the U18s it would create a pathway for young players to be given opportunities as well as older players who are important mentor figures for young players to be

able to play without having to worry about what happens when a PL side must leave out 8 players on a Saturday because they have taken a squad of 40 and not had any injuries.

- The second is that it creates a pathway for clubs to be able to bring players in to their flagship sides again without having to register them full time in the squads. If a club has a PL team and an AL2 team, and the PL side needs to borrow players because of a shortage, the best U18 player should be called upon to be given an opportunity to play up as the idea is for them to be able to play with them in the coming years. They should not be limited to a certain number of appearances as that is limiting their opportunities to develop. It may not happen to every club every season, but having seen towards the back end of the 2017 season how many players are being borrowed by PL teams, there is clearly an issue.

It is my understanding that clubs have abused the borrowing system in the past however I don't see that as a possibility now because of the club wide gradings given to players A7(f) and (i), clubs would not be allowed to register players in ALs as well as PLs to circumvent the grading system. The benefits of changing the rule would include

- Allowing U18s to have Premier League experience without having to register them in the squad full time. They might not be ready for the physicality of the league or might have difficulty balancing HSC or schoolwork and football.
- Allow players doing well in ALs to be given opportunities in Premier League with the vision of being promoted to the squad in the future.

There are of the possibilities of problems however as I see it Clubs with a team in AL1s and PLs cannot get their AL1s team promoted thus would not be inclined to drop PL players down for the purposed of winning AL1s if they registered their players in AL1s and played them in PLs every week. Similarly, PL teams can get relegated so clubs would be even less inclined to play players down simply to win a trophy.

14.21 Change 25:

5.2 COUNCIL

- (1) The Council shall meet in February, March, April ,May, June, July, August and November and/or December and at such other times as deemed necessary by the E.C., or as required by these rules.

Change To:

- (1) The Council shall meet in February, March, April ,May, June, July, August and at least one further meeting before the AGM and at such other times as deemed necessary by the E.C., or as required by these rules.

CARRIED

PART 13 AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS AND PLAYING RULES

- (1) These rules shall not be amended or added to without the consent of three quarters of the voters present at an A.G.M. or S.G.M., providing that there shall be no more than four (4) such meetings between consecutive A.G.M. and unless fourteen (14) days notice, in writing, has been given to all members.
- (2) Playing rules may be changed at ordinary meetings of the Council prior to the close of entries to the competitions, and thereafter at an A.G.M., provided that fourteen (14) days notice has been given to all members.

- (3) Any notice of motion for alteration to these rules must be lodged with the Secretary no later than twenty one (21) days prior to the date set for the meeting at which they are to be decided upon.
- (4) The E.C. shall have the power to deal with any matters not provided for in these rules.
- (5) The September Council meeting shall be the "Policy Meeting", at which proposals for amendments to the Articles of Association and Playing Rules shall be put forward and discussed. Proposals for consideration at this meeting shall be made in writing, referencing to the relevant section of the Articles of Association and Playing Rules, to the Secretary no later than the July Council Meeting.
 - (i) Decisions at this meeting shall go forward to the A.G.M. as recommendations only, and shall not be binding on members.
 - (ii) Proposed amendments which are subject of recommendations to the A.G.M. shall be put to the vote at the A.G.M. without debate.

Change To:

- (1) The MWFA Articles and Bylaws shall not be amended or added to without the consent of three quarters of the voters present at an A.G.M. or S.G.M. and unless fourteen (14) days notice has been given to all members.
- (2) Playing Rules may be changed at ordinary meetings of the Council prior to the date of the Close of Entries to the Competitions provided that fourteen (14) days notice has been given to all members.
- (3) Playing Rule changes after the Close of Entries to the Competition may be made as follows:
 - (a) If the Playing Rule change is to come into immediate effect during the current football year then the change must be made at a S.G.M., provided that fourteen (14) days notice has been given to all members.
 - (b) If the Playing Rule change is to come into effect in subsequent Football Years then the change may be made ordinary meetings of the Council provided that fourteen (14) days notice has been given to all members.
- (4) Any notice of motion for alteration to these rules must be lodged with the Secretary no later than twenty one (21) days prior to the date set for the meeting at which they are to be decided upon.
- (5) The E.C. shall have the power to deal with any matters not provided for in these rules.
- (6) The MWFA EC will accept proposals for amendments to the Articles of Association Bylaws and Playing Rules to be submitted to the AGM for approval. Any proposed amendments from Clubs should be submitted by the end of the September before the AGM.
These proposals to be submitted to the AGM will follow the following procedure:
 - (a) the proposed amendments will be submitted to the Clubs two weeks prior to the Council meeting at which they are to be considered.
 - (b) at the Council meeting the proposed amendments will be discussed and may be further amended before step (3).
 - (c) a vote will be taken at the Council meeting as to whether a proposed amendment , including any agreed changes will be submitted to the AGM as a resolution. Any proposed amendment forward to the AGM as a resolution shall not be binding on members.
 - (d) These resolutions shall be put to the vote at the AGM without debate.
- (7)** Proposals for amendments to the Articles of Association, Bylaws and Playing Rules not submitted to the AGM in this way must follow parts 13 (1) or 13 (2) or 13 (3). **CARRIED**

14.22 Change 27:

(ii) Open Competitions

- (c) A player registered in an U21 Age Group or below can play as a Borrowed Player in any Open Division.

Change To:

- (c) Teams in Open Competitions may borrow players from the U18 Competition as follows:
- AL3 and above may borrow from U18-1
 - Any AL Division may borrow from U18-2 and below
- Teams in Womens Open Competitions may borrow players from the W18 Competition as follows:
- WAL2 and above may borrow from W18-1
 - Any WAL division may borrow players from W18-2 and below
- A true age player registered in an U16 Age Group can play as a Borrowed Player in any Open Division

14. Adoption of 2018 Budget

The 2018 budget has not yet been finalised as Football NSW fees have only just been received in the past week. A draft budget has been shared with Jeff & David, the EC & MC are yet to sign off on those numbers.

The general fee increases that have come through from FNSW are only in their insurance (due to a new insurer), these are \$0.53 for divisions under 18's & \$5.10 for over 18. It is a recommendation that we pass these increases on to the players.

We are projecting a loss of \$50,000 in 2018.

A telephone conference will be held with Joseph Sobara once the 2018 Budget is finalised.

15. Election of Auditor

Joseph Sobara moved that Watsons Corporate Services (previously CKC) continue to be auditor in 2018, seconded by Keith Pester.
