### **FOOTBALL NSW STATE AWARD 2017**

### **JEREMY TOIVONEN**

Jeremy Toivonen was General Manager at Manly Warringah Football Association for 17 years, spearheading the transition from volunteer organization to the second biggest Football Association in NSW.

When Jeremy started at MWFA in 2000 he was the sole employee responsible for 9,000 players and he has helped grow the Association to now have 17,500 registered players.

Jeremy has also been instrumental in helping forge close ties between the MWFA (grassroots) and Manly United (elite NPL Club), ensuring a streamlined and simple elite player development pathway from grassroots to the NPL — men and women.

Jeremy played a role in the growth of the elite player program for junior players on the Northern Beaches (MWFA and Manly United) to the point the two bodies now field teams in the Senior Men's NPL 1, Senior Women's NPL 1, Boys Youth League, Girls Youth League, Association Youth League, Girls SAP and Boys SAP (two licenses) as well as Development Squads for 6-9 year old boys and girls.

Jeremy has also played a huge role in improving the Cromer Park facility to be the best Association football facility in Australia through the various projects that has seen the development of the following:

- The Lucas Neill grandstand and seating for 2,000 people
- The construction of a synthetic field on Cromer Park No. 1 with Cromer Park No. 2 synthetic to be completed within the next month
- A new amenities building for the main field as well as a secondary amenities building for the outside fields
- A deeper relationship with Warringah Council to help bring three turf fields (Cromer Park 3, 4 and
   5) up to standard through the Cromer Park Masterplan as well as improvements to parking for all five fields.
- Implementation of the MWFA facilities and development levy and project, which is helping secure better facilities (synthetic fields, lighting and amenities for grassroots clubs all over the Northern Beaches

Jeremy's contribution to football on the Northern Beaches has been immense and MWFA feels his contribution deserves recognition with the Football NSW State Award.

Over the years there have been a number of amalgamations of MWFA Clubs to form the current 17 Clubs. A brief history is given below:

Avalon Junior and Senior Clubs merged in 1982.

Belrose Rangers Soccer Club (founded 1978) and Terrey Hills Soccer Club merged in 1986 to become the BTH Raiders Football Club.

Brookvale FC started as Manly Milan Soccer Club in 1962 and then changed name to Brookvale FC in 1971.

Manly Soccer Club (founded 1949) and Allambie Soccer Club (founded 1963) merged in 1992 to become the Manly Allambie United Football Club

Forest Killamey Soccer Football Club formed in 1962 with 2 teams and then split in 1969 to form Killarney Heights Soccer Club and Forest Soccer Club. These two Clubs then merged again in 1993 to form Forest Killarney Football Club

Cromer Strikers Soccer Club and Collaroy Plateau Youth Club merged in 1995 to form Collaroy Cromer Strikers Football Club.

Pittwater was formed in 1964 as a soccer section of the Pittwater RSL Youth Club. In 1966 the Football Section became a separate entity - what is now Pittwater RSL FC.

Harbord Diggers Soccer Club (founded 1947/48) and Seasiders Soccer Club (Men's founded 1982 and joined by Queenscliff Women's in 1991) merged in 2004 to form Harbord Seasiders United Football Club



































### **WAKEHURST FOOTBALL CLUB - 50 YEARS IN 2017**

2017 marked the 50th season that the Wakehurst Football Club has participated in MWFA competitions.



From humble beginnings in 1968 with 102 players the club has grown to be one of the largest in the MWFA with over 1,400 players in 106 teams this year.

To celebrate this milestone the club decided to have a new playing strip for the 2017 season.

The Wakehurst FC community was asked to submit designs for the playing strip. The Committee reviewed the over one hundred designs submitted and selected five for the Wakehurst FC community to vote on.

The winning design is shown, and was used for the 1st game of the 2017 season, the U18/1 game on Friday night 30 March, 2017.

A 50th Anniversary Gala Dinner was held at the Balgowlah RSL on Saturday 1st April. The night was hosted by Ray Martin and nearly two hundred past & present members of the WFC community attended.

### PRESIDENT'S REPORT



Well another year has come and gone so fast, and what a year it has been. 2017 must go down as one of the best seasons ever for the MWFA and football on the Northern Beaches. The success and development across the whole association in the past 12 months has been unprecedented. Everyone involved in this great association has contributed and we collectively have set a new, very high, bench mark. I'm sure that we can continue to improve and make our great game even better here in our backyard.

2017 was my 3<sup>rd</sup> as president and again it was busy, productive, challenging and rewarding. Lots of things have been put into motion and our steady development is on track.

The beginning of the year was very wet, constant rain from late February till early April which meant a lot of grading's and preseason plans were all put on hold. The positive was the fields never looked so good at season kick off.

2017 was a year of some big changes, some planned, and some not.

A new position was established, Community Coaching Coordinator. This role was to assist our 17 clubs in coach education, which is an important part of our development as an Association and a sport. Next phase will be a long term plan for our privately owned club house and land to ensure benefits flow back throughout the entire football community. Exciting times ahead.

I wish to thank all the Executive and Management Committees for all their efforts and more importantly, their time over the past year, and I look forward to working with them all again over the next 12 months Lastly I would like to thank my wife, Wendy and my kids for the support and for allowing me to give something back to the game that has given me and my family so much enjoyment over many years.

### MANLY WARRINGAH FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION DEFIB PROJECT



Following two deaths in 2 years on the playing fields of the MWFA a program was started to enable the 19 clubs in our Association to purchase Automated Emergency Defibrillator's (AED) with 50% Association funding.

Having met at the wake of their former team mate, John Tansley (Beacon Hill) and Terry Gatward (Many Vale) decided to form a project team with the goal of having coverage at all Senior Games from 2017.

Invitations were sent out and the project team which was formed consisted of Rob Brennan (MWRFA), Nik Scott (Mosman), Vincent Roperti and Geoff Mooney (Curl Curl), Remy Bourcier (CC Strikers) and Duncan Kerr (Forest Killarney).

Best Practice Guidelines were written and issued to all clubs and it was decided that full coverage would best be achieved by having portable AED's at 36 grounds. All Clubs were asked to purchase AED units to achieve coverage goals and appoint a "Defib Manager".

The project team provided flags to be used at each ground so the location of the AED was clear, the flags also helped raise awareness. They also commissioned a 10 minute training video which was made available to all players and referees on how to use the AED's.

Referees reported any games where a AED was not present but we believe we acheived around 99% coverage at senior games this season.

A pre-season Gala day was organised but unfortunately rained off twice. Fund raising events were organised and held and awareness was pushed through local media and Football Association Media channels. A Zap stand was installed at MWFA HQ - Cromer Park. This is a permanently sited 24-hour available AED suitable for high traffic public spaces. The Cromer Park Zap stand had an official opening by the local State MP and Minister for Health Brad Hazzard. The event got national coverage from Chanel 7 News and around 100 people from MWFA, Football NSW, local emergency services and representatives from clubs and referees.

A big thank you to clubs who have supported this project financially as well as making sure that the AEDs and Flags were out for all senior games. Also to the MWFA Management committee who provided the budget to ensure that this project could go ahead.

The project team wishes to have more Zap stations across our high usage grounds and is working with council and community groups to get funding. We all now feel confident that if there is another sudden cardiac arrest during a senior game in MWFA that the equipment will be available, along with people who will be confident to use it and help avert another death.
